

Policy for Basketball Goals in the Traditions Subdivision

The following policy covers basketball goals in the Traditions Subdivision with the input from the Flowood Police Department, Home-Land Management Company and the POA Board:

- Basketball goals must be placed in the upper part of the resident's driveway
- Basketball goals cannot be permanently attached to the resident's home (i.e., to the roof, over the garage, etc.) or the basketball goal post permanently secured in the lawn.
- Basketball goals cannot be positioned at the bottom of the driveway with the goal facing the street or the with goal facing the home. This will prevent individuals or the ball from playing on or entering the street thus causing a traffic and a personal hazard.
- Basketball goals cannot be located on the subdivision's streets as the Flowood Police Department will consider the basketball goal a traffic impairment violation for the resident if the Flowood Police Department are notified of the incident.
